Artist Presentation: Robin Maxon

About the artist:

Robin is a graphic designer by trade and an artist at heart. She has worked as an art director, a newspaper staff artist and has owned her own graphic design business since 1987.

Robin's graphic design background influences her painting style giving it an illustrative component with more emphasis on realism. She is intrigued with the many ways paint can be applied and enjoys seeing the results of adding other mediums to her watercolors such as ink, gouache and markers. When Robin paints she attempts to capture the light and color of something common, natural or unexpected. She appreciates the beauty of a simple moment or the expression and play of light on the subject. If you would like to see some of Robin's watercolor paintings her website is www.RobinMaxon.com.

Robin is going to do a power point presentation she calls "Commission, the challenges and rewards." The presentation itself will show a variety of her commissioned pieces and she will tell some of the side stories that go along with them. The main emphasis will be on the white tail deer 'challenge' which shows her steps from receiving a picture of 3 mounted deer head from a client to making a composition of 3 deer in a meadow, masking, watercolor washes and painting the detail for a completed commission. She'll also talk about the business side of commissioned painting.

I chose the painting by **Trinity Hess** titled "**Freedom of the Mind.**" Trinity is 16 years old and a junior at John Glenn High School.

I'm not an art critic by any means, but here are the reasons I chose this painting.

- 1. Trinity painted from her imagination and the subject matter is very creative.
- 2. The contrast between cool and warm colors is well done. Her unusual color choices fit the subject matter.
- 3. There are some beautiful shapes in the painting, particularly in the hair.
- 4. And finally, I'm a pushover for birds. Trinity painted the birds with sensitivity but they aren't cute or saccharin. The birds fit the mood of the painting.


